This proposed amendment would establish uniform term limits for the prosecuting attorney, mayor, and councilmembers limited to three consecutive four-year terms. Term limits would be equitably applied to all present and future elected officials by requiring that consecutive four-year terms served by elected officials in office on January 1, 2017, would be counted toward the term limits.

Should the terms for prosecuting attorney, mayor and councilmembers be limited to three consecutive four-year terms?

Present Situation

The mayor and councilmembers are limited to two consecutive four-year terms and there are no term limits for the prosecuting attorney.

If Proposal Passes

The term limits for prosecuting attorney, mayor, and councilmembers would be three consecutive four-year terms. Consecutive four-year terms served by elected officials in office on January 1, 2017, would be counted toward the term limits.
