This proposed amendment would allow the mayor to designate the managing director and deputy managing director to sign instruments requiring execution by the city and to designate the administrative head of an executive department or office to sign instruments required for execution by the city that affect their department or office.

Question

Should the mayor have the authority to delegate the signing of documents to another city officer?

Present Situation

A significant number of documents require the mayor's signature, many of which are recurring or involve business decisions of less significance to city operations. This situation consumes an unwarranted amount of the mayor's limited time and slows the approval process.

If Proposal Passes

The managing director and deputy managing director would be authorized to sign instruments requiring execution by the city that are recurring or of less significance to city operations, and the administrative head of an executive department or office would be authorized to sign instruments requiring execution by the city that affect their respective department or office.
