

## **Proposals 48 and 73 combined**

### **Digest**

This proposed amendment would require the city to use its powers to serve the people of Honolulu in a sustainable and transparent manner and to promote stewardship of natural resources for future generations, and create an Office of Climate Change, Sustainability and Resiliency in the Managing Director's Office. The Office will be headed by an executive who, among other duties, will convene a commission of five experts in the fields of climate change, resiliency and sustainability to provide information and guidance.

### **Question**

Should the city use its powers to serve the people in a sustainable and transparent manner and to promote stewardship of natural resources for future generations; and should the city create an Office of Climate Change, Sustainability and Resiliency?
