**Section 17-106. Rates, Revenues and Appropriations --**

The board shall fix and adjust reasonable rates and charges for the fixed guideway system so that the revenues derived therefrom, in conjunction with revenues received from the general excise and use tax surcharge, from the federal government, and from the revenue-generating properties of the authority, shall be sufficient or as nearly sufficient as possible, to support the fixed guideway system and the authority. The authority shall submit a line-item appropriation request for each of its proposed operating and capital budgets for the ensuing fiscal year to the council through the office of the mayor by December 1st of each year. **[The] Not less than one hundred twenty days prior to the end of the fiscal year, the** office of the mayor shall submit the authority's line-item appropriation requests, **with or** without alteration or amendment, **to the council**. The council shall, with or without amendments, approve the authority's appropriation requests. \_
