Require excess city property, such as schools on city land that the DOE no longer wants, to find its highest and best use in the community. Today, excess city property is claimed by whichever city department asks for it first, and only if no departments want it will the public get an opportunity to compete for it through an RFP. For example, when Wailupe School closed, many different charter schools wanted to use the facilities for school use. However, the Parks Department decided to take much of the space even though there was no public movement for a Parks facility there. Many worthy charter schools could have better used the property for its original intended purpose and generated revenue for the City.
